How does this benefit the company?

A person can only be a true leader if he or she understands the dynamics that play a role in his or her own life. A true leader is authentic and leads with integrity. Authenticity is about self-knowledge and truthfulness, and integrity is about being reliable and living truthfully - things that cannot be trained through theoretical models.

Leadership development courses have limited impact on the individual, his growth or his influence in the workplace because these courses often focus on skills transfer and don't effect deep change.

This unique one-day workshop is aimed at helping individuals uncover their innate leadership abilities so that they can influence and inspire their teams to make a soul-inspired difference in all of their relationships. Participants will work through an introspective process to understand the real issues that influence them in their lives. This will be followed by a facilitated practical session, based on well-researched theory, during which they will be led to plot their own stories. The workshop will end with sharing leadership stories.

Participants will take home:

- Their own story
- A wealth of self-knowledge
- Deep learning from listening to others' stories and sharing their own
- A leadership charter for further development

Why story?

Telling stories and learning from them are native to human beings. We use our own and other people's stories to make sense of our own lives and to understand what we experience as real. We also use stories to teach and to bring insight into situations where the rules of logic are blurred. Stories can take many forms, from biographical stories to hero myths, legends and anecdotes. All of them are valuable in the workplace.

It is both a craft and a form of art to utilise the stories that surround us to transfer knowledge, facilitate deep understanding and change, and to motivate and positively influence the people around us.

This workshop will be the beginning of a life-long focus on being true to your inner leader and living authentically - and transferring this learning to others in your circle of influence.
